Addendum to the Grand Jury Report of the Loudon County Grand Jury for the April 20016 Term (Monday and Tuesday, April 11th and 12th)

The Loudon County Grand Jury heard a report of the TBI investigation into an officer involved shooting involving Loudon County Sheriff's Investigators Lt. Patrick Upton and Jason Smith wherein the shot and killed a subject (Thong Vandarack) while attempting to serve an arrest warrant on him for aggravated statutory rape. Upon being let into the residence by Vandarack's girlfriend, Vandarack came around the corner with what appeared to be a handgun that he pulled from his waist. One of the officers ordered him to 'don't do it'. Both Smith and Upton shot multiple times resulting in Vandarack's death. The TBI took statements from Vandarack's live-in girlfriend and her teenage child wherein they indicated that the gun was an AirSoft pistol that Vandarack had the day or two before removed the orange safety tip making it look like a real handgun. According to the statements Vandarack did this as he knew he was the subject of the criminal investigation and that he was 'not going back to prison'. Vandarack had previously served a lengthy prison sentence in Wisconsin for attempted murder (X2). His history indicated gang affiliation with the Laotian Kings and other groups.

The Grand Jury heard this report and voted that no further action was necessary in the way of additional investigation or the need for an indictment.

The Loudon County Grand Jury also heard a report of the TBI investigation into an officer involved shooting involving Lenoir City Police Officer Tyrel Lorenz shooting and killing a Josh Grubb who was the driver of a Dodge Dakota pickup truck that was the subject of a possible DUI consensual encounter at Bimbo's convenience center in Lenoir City in the early morning hours of March 13, 2016. The Grand Jury reviewed the provisional autopsy report with toxicology report showing the levels of alcohol, methamphetamine and other prescription drugs in Grubb's system. Grubb was driving the truck as an unlicensed driver and according to the statement of Officer Lorenz smelled of alcohol along with the other passengers. Lorenz was placing a passenger, Brandon Taylor, under arrest for public intoxication and had Taylor in handcuffs when Grubb started the truck and began to take off from the gas pumps. Officer Lorenz ordered Grubb to stop and went around the pumps to try to stop the truck, ultimately ending up in the bed of the truck. As Grubb sped off into the four lane Highway 321 in spite of Lorenz's commands to stop, Lorenz shot Grubb nine times through the back window in what Lorenz contended was an attempt to stop Grubb as Lorenz was in fear for his life and the safety and life of others on Highway 321 or even Interstate 75. The Grand Jury viewed in car camera video, body camera video and security video from Bimbo's of the incident.
